91% of respondents in the survey were women. This could suggest men are less likely to join support groups

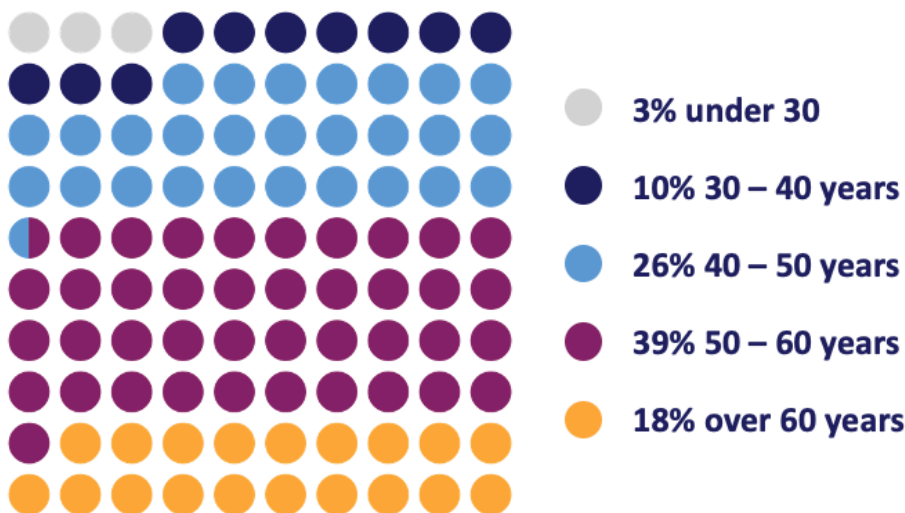
Most respondents (65%) were aged between 40-60 years, also suggesting the role of aging, menopause, and hormone influences in INOCA conditions

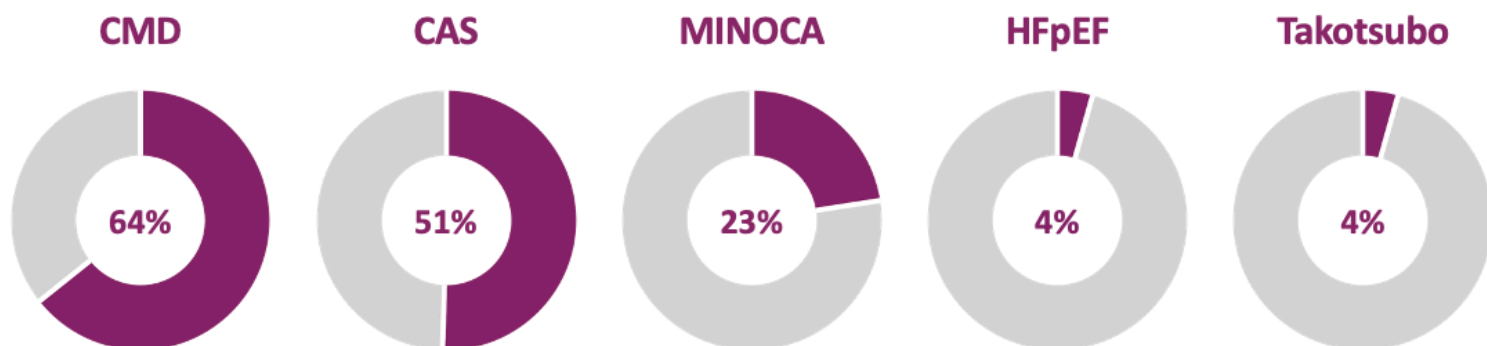
Age at diagnosis
